ABOUT THE TORAH READING

Artscroll Stone Chumash: pages 726—747

1st Aliyah: Parshat Bamidbar G-d commands Moshe to take a census of the people. **2nd Aliyah:** The Torah records the results of the census for each of the Twelve Tribes separately and the total of all males, between the ages 20 and 60, as 603,550. **3rd Aliyah:** G-d tells Moshe how to set up the Camp: Four encampments, of three tribes each, at each side of the camp surrounding the camp of Levites and the Mishkan in the center. **4th Aliyah:** The names of the children of Aharon. G-d tells Moshe to appoint the Levites to safeguard the items of the Mishkan. The Levites are to replace the firstborn. **5th Aliyah:** G-d tells Moshe to take a census of the tribe of Levi. Moshe and Aharon count 22,000 Levites. **6th Aliyah:** G-d tells Moshe to count every firstborn male of the people, have the Levites redeem each firstborn and redeem the remaining firstborn with five shekels each. **7th Aliyah:** The Levite family of Kehat is counted (males ages 30-50) and charged with the duties of carrying the holy items contained within the Mishkan.

Haftarah (pages 1180-1181): Taken from the book of Hosea (2:1-22), the prophet likens the population of the people to the sands of the sea.

Take a census of the entire assembly of the Children of Israel. (1:2)

Question: Our sages say that G-d always counts the Jewish people because of His love for them. What does counting Jews have to do with 'loving' them? What lesson can we learn from the counting of the Jewish people?

Answer: There are different levels of observance among Jews, with some apparently keeping G-d's commandments more strictly and some less. The Yetzer Hora will at times tempt A person to belittle the worth of a less observant Jew, saying: "He is a worth less than I, after all I am more religious than him/her!" When G-d commanded Moses to count the Jewish people, He instructed him to count each Jew as "one," no more and no less. G-d's message was that the Jewish people are His children; each one is equally and unconditionally beloved and all have essential and equal value.
