ABOUT THE TORAH READING

Artscroll Stone Chumash: pages 340—365

1st Aliyah: Parshat Bo begins, continuing the story of the remaining Ten Plagues. G-d tells Moshe to warn Pharaoh of the eighth plague, a devastating swarm of locusts. **2nd Aliyah:** Moshe summons the plague of locusts. All vegetation in Egypt is consumed. Pharaoh confesses his sin and begs Moshe to remove the plague. Moshe prays and a wind blows away the locusts from Egypt. G-d tells Moshe to summon the ninth plague of darkness. All of Egypt is engulfed in darkness. **3rd Aliyah:** G-d tells Moshe to warn Pharaoh of the last, most devastating plague.

4th Aliyah: Moshe warns Pharaoh that at midnight all the firstborn of Egypt will die. G-d then tells Moshe to teach the people about the Pesach offering -that its blood shall be placed on the doorposts- and the Pesach festival. **5th Aliyah:** Moshe instructs the people regarding G-d's commandments. They do as they are instructed. **6th Aliyah:** At midnight, all the firstborn of Egypt die. Pharaoh allows the Children of Israel with all their animals to leave Egypt. **7th Aliyah:** G-d calls Moshe to sanctify all the firstborn of Israel. The people are to forever remember their Exodus from Egypt.

Haftarah (page 1151): Jeremiah (46:13-28), the prophet describes the defeat of Egypt at the hands of Babylonia at the end of the First Temple period.

Parasha thought

"Do not eat of it partially raw, or cooked in water, only roasted over fire." (12:9)

Question: The meat of the sacrifices may be eaten by Kohens in whatever manner suits their palates. They may eat it cooked, broiled or roasted, etc. Why did G-d insist that the Pesach-offering be eaten only roasted?

Answer: Partially raw and fully cooked meat hardly have an aroma. Roasted meat, however, can be smelled at a distance. The Jews slaved in Egypt for many years and were petrified of their Egyptian masters. G-d's command to offer sheep, the animal worshipped by the Egyptians, as a Pesach-offering, frightened them. In order not to arouse the wrath of the Egyptians, they were going to eat it partially raw or fully cooked, hoping that the Egyptians would not notice. Consequently, G-d told Moses to tell the people, "Enough is enough! Stop walking with your heads bowed down. Lift them up and be proud of the fact that you are Jews and free people. Roast the sacrifice on fire, let the aroma be smelled from one end of Egypt to the other, and let the entire country know that you are proudly worshipping your G-d."
