ABOUT THE SHABBAT TORAH READING

1st Aliyah: Moshe makes Two requests from Hashem. Moshe asks Hashem to make Himself known completely and truly to Moshe, and to accompany the Jews on their journey's. **2nd Aliyah:** Hashem agrees to grant Moshe's Second request and accompany the Jews. **3rd Aliyah:** Hashem informs Moshe that no Human Being can ever fully see and know Hashem while remaining physically alive. Moshe would get to see Hashem only from 'His Back.' **4th Aliyah:** Moshe is instructed to carve out a Second set of Luchot. **5th Aliyah:** Hashem teaches Moshe about the: 'Thirteen attributes of Divine mercy. Whenever Jews pray before Hashem and mention them, Hashem will always respond. **6th Aliyah:** The Commandments against intermarriage and Idol worship. **7th Aliyah:** The Jews are commanded regarding the Three Festivals: Pesach, Shavuot and Sukkot. During these Festivals, every Jewish man was obligated to make the journey and pilgrimage up to the Beit Hamikdash.
