ABOUT THE TORAH READING

Artscroll Stone Chumash: Pages 656—671

1st Aliyah: Parshat Kedoshim begins a whole series of different mitzvot under the general calling to be “holy”: to revere one’s parents, the Sabbath, not to turn to idols, the rejected offerings (*pigul*), gifts to the poor, mitzvot regarding honesty and righteousness. **2nd Aliyah:** Continuing mitzvot regarding honesty and righteousness, to love one’s fellow, forbidden mixtures, the designated maid (*shifcha charufa*). **3rd Aliyah:** The mitzvah of *orlah*, prohibitions against shaving, tattooing, self-mutilation, to revere the Sabbath and the elderly. **4th Aliyah:** Not to taunt

the Jewish convert and the mitzvah regarding honest weights and measurements. **5th Aliyah:** God commands Moshe regarding the cult of Molech and the necromancy of Ov and Yidoni. **6th Aliyah:** The punishments for forbidden sexual relationships. **7th Aliyah:** The Land’s intolerance of sexual immorality.

Haftarah (pages 1174—1175): In the Haftarah, taken from the book of Ezekiel (22:1-16), the prophet chastises the people for their horrible behavior. In theme with parshat Kedoshim, the people swing from sublime holiness to the worst sort of cruelty and inhuman and unholy behavior. God warns the people of the coming Exile.

An Interesting Midrash

Speak to the Congregation of Israel and say to them, ‘You shall be holy.’ ” (19:2)

QUESTION: Rashi comments: “This *parshah* was stated *behakheil* — in an assembly.” Why does the Torah want us to know the circumstances surrounding the transmission of this *parshah*?

ANSWER: There are people who are pious and careful about matters of Torah and *mitzvot* in their homes, but reluctant to appear “too Jewish” in public.

This attitude is summed up in a slogan by the originators of the Reform movement: “*Yebudi bebeitcha ve’adam betzeitecha*” — “Be a Jew at home and a normal person in the street.”

Rashi wants to emphasize that Jews must be holy at all times. They should conduct themselves according to the Will of Hashem not only in the privacy of their home, but even “*behakheil*” — when they are out in the “assembly” of other people — even there they should proudly display the holiness of the Jewish people.
