ABOUT THE TORAH READING

Artscroll Stone Chumash: Pages 774—797

1st Aliyah: Parshat Beha'alotcha begins with God telling Moshe to instruct Aharon regarding the Menorah. **2nd Aliyah:** The Levites purify themselves and are consecrated to serve in the Mishkan. **3rd Aliyah:** Exactly one year after the Exodus, God tells Moshe that the people should bring the Pesach offering as was done in Egypt. God instructs Moshe regarding the Pesach Shenit. **4th Aliyah:** How God communicated with the people so they would know when to

continue their journey through the wilderness and when to encamp. **5th Aliyah:** Moshe speaks to his father-in-law to come with the people to the Promised Land. **6th Aliyah:** Moshe's declaration as the Ark would begin its journey and as it would rest. The story of the people's complaining over the manna. God tells Moshe to gather seventy men to be the elders of the people and promises to send the people meat. The story of the prophecy given to the seventy men. **7th Aliyah:** Swarms of quail come to the Camp. The people eat and are then punished by God. The story of Miriam's affliction. The uniqueness of Moshe's prophecy. Miriam is sent outside the Camp for seven days. The people wait for her return and then continue their journey.

Haftarah (pages 1182-1184): Taken from the book of Zechariah (2:14), the prophet predicts the rebuilding of the Beit Hamikdash after seventy years of exile and despair in Babylonia.

An Interesting Thought;

But now our soul is dried away; there is nothing at all; we have nothing but the manna to look to. (11:6)

Question: The manna tasted like cake fried in honey, and one could experience any taste his palate desired. Why did they complain?

Answer: The Talmud says that a righteous person (*tzaddik*) would find it at the entrance to his tent, ready to eat. An intermediate person (*beinoni*) would have to leave the camp to find his portion, and would find it in the form of prepared dough, that needs only to be baked. A wicked person (*rasha*) would have to go a great distance, his Manna was raw matter which had to be ground in the mill, and afterwards cooked or baked. Thus, every morning when the people went out for their portions of manna, it was obvious who was righteous, average or wicked. The people who complained against the manna were the wicked. They pretended to be dissatisfied with its taste although they were really disgruntled at having their true identity revealed. They thus wanted to "have their cake and eat it" — to have a righteous person's portion and thus appear to be righteous individuals while still living frivolous and sinful lives.
