ABOUT THE TORAH READING

Artscroll Stone Chumash: pages 444—463

1st Aliyah: Parshat Terumah begins with G-d telling Moshe to instruct the people to dedicate the different materials necessary to construct the Mishkan (i.e. the Tabernacle). The rest of the parsha relates the instructions to fashion each item to be contained within the Mishkan and the structure of the Mishkan itself, beginning with the Ark (*aron*). **2nd Aliyah:** To fashion the Cover of the Ark (*kaporet*) and the images of the *keruvim*. To fashion the Table (*shulchan*) on which will be placed the show-bread (*lechem hapanim*). **3rd Aliyah:** To fashion the Menorah. To fashion the Curtains (*yeri'ot*) to cover the Mishkan. **4th Aliyah:** To fashion the Planks (*kerashim*) with which the walls of the Mishkan were made. **5th Aliyah:** To

fashion the Partition (*parochet*) to separate between the Holy of Holies and the rest of the Mishkan. How the items within the Mishkan are to be arranged. To fashion the Screen (*masach*) as the entrance into the Mishkan. **6th Aliyah:** To fashion the Outer Altar (*mizbe'ach*). **7th Aliyah:** To fashion the Lace-Hangings (*kela'im*) that will enclose the Courtyard (*chatzar*) surrounding the Mishkan.

Haftarah (pages 1157—1158): I KINGS 5:26 – 6:13. The Haftarah tells the Story of Shlomo Hamelech's construction the first Temple, following the theme of the Parasha, which discusses the construction of the Tabernacle.

When did Hashem command the Jews to build the Mishkan?

Rashi, the primary commentary on Torah, makes a radical departure from the straight-up reading of the text. He alters the scriptural order and places this command – and in fact the whole description and implementation of the centralized "location and structure" for G-d's presence – after the story of the Golden Calf, which the Torah records seven chapters later! **The Zohar** places the commandment to create a Sanctuary and the Jewish people's donation of the materials used for its construction prior to the Golden Calf affair. (That's why the Calf was made from personal jewelry; all the gold they took from Egypt had already been donated to the Sanctuary project.)

Nachmanides, maintains the literal timeline recorded in the Torah is chronologically correct: the Golden Calf incident occurred smack in between the commandment to create a Sanctuary and the Jewish people's compliance.
