ABOUT THE TORAH READING

Artscroll Stone Chumash: Pages 78—105

1st Aliyah: Parshat Vayera begins with the story of the three angels that visit Avraham and inform him that Sarah his wife will have a son in her old age. **2nd Aliyah:** Avraham pleads with G-d to spare the cities of Sodom and Gomorrah in the merit of the righteous people that dwell there. **3rd Aliyah:** The two angles come to Sodom, they save Lot and his family and destroy the wicked cities. **4th Aliyah:** Lot survives with his two daughters who subsequently seduce their father and become pregnant. They give birth to sons from whom the nations of Moav and Bnei Amon descend. The story of Avraham's journey to Gerar, Sarah's abduction by the king of Gerar, Avimelech, and her safe return. The birth of Yitzchak. **5th Aliyah:** The story of how Hagar and her son Yishmael

were expelled from the house of Avraham. **6th Aliyah:** The covenant made between Avraham and Avimelech at Beer-Sheva. **7th Aliyah:** The story of the Binding of Yitzchak, Avraham's greatest trial of faith, to sacrifice his beloved son Yitzchak. At the last moment, G-d tells Avraham not to kill Yitzchak. Avraham sacrifices a ram in his son's place. G-d reaffirms His covenant with Avraham. The birth of Rivkah.

Haftarah (pages 1134—1135): Taken from the second book of Kings (4:1-37), the Haftarah tells the dramatic story of the Shunamite woman.

Dvar Torah contributed by Rabbi Kesselman

“And behold three men [angels] were standing over him.” (18:2)

Question: Abraham was sick and G-d came to visit him. One of the three "men" who came with G-d was the angel Raphael, who came to heal Abraham (*Rashi*). Why didn't G-d, who is the healer of all flesh, dismiss Raphael and take over the healing?

Answer: Often, when people visit the sick, they have a tendency to discuss the ailment and offer uncalled-for advice. G-d is teaching us an important lesson in visiting the sick: When visiting a sick person, do not become his doctor. Let the attending physician use his expertise to heal the patient. Although G-d is the true healer and every doctor is His emissary, He permitted the *assigned* doctor, Raphael, to complete his mission and cure Abraham.
